COOKIES POLICY

INFORMATION ABOUT COOKIES

Due to the entry into force of the referent modification of the "Information Society Services Law" (LSSICE) established by Royal Decree 13/2012, it is mandatory to obtain the express consent of the user of all web pages that They use expendable Cookies, before it navigates through them.

1.- Definition and function of cookies.

A cookie is a file that is downloaded to the user's computer/Smartphone/Tablet (device) when accessing certain web pages to store and retrieve information about the browsing or browsing habits that are carried out from said device. Depending on the information it contains and the way the equipment is used, the user could be recognized. 2.- What types of cookies does <https://www.lanissuites.com/> use?

- Own Cookies: These are those that are sent to the user's terminal equipment from a computer or domain managed by the editor itself and from which the service requested by the user is provided.
- Third-party cookies: These are those that are sent to the user's terminal equipment from a computer or domain that is not managed by the editor, but by another entity that processes the data obtained through cookies.
- Session Cookies: These are a type of cookies designed to collect and store data while the user accesses a web page.
- Persistent cookies: These are a type of cookie in which the data is still stored in the terminal and can be accessed and processed for a period defined by the person responsible for the cookie, which can range from a few minutes to several years.
- Analysis cookies: These are those that, well treated by us or by third parties, allow us to quantify the number of users and thus carry out the statistical measurement and analysis of the use made by users of the service offered. For this, your browsing on our website is analyzed in order to improve the offer of products or services that we offer you.

2.1 Regarding the types of cookies, there are five large groups:

- Analytical cookies: they collect information on the use made of the website.
- Social cookies: are those necessary for external social networks.
- Affiliate cookies: they allow you to track visits from other websites, with which the website establishes an affiliation contract (affiliation companies).

- Advertising and behavioral cookies: they collect information about the user's preferences and personal choices (retargeting).
- Technical and functional cookies: these are strictly necessary for the use of the website and for the provision of the contracted service.

3.- Deactivation, revocation or elimination of cookies.

The user may, at any time, allow, block or delete the cookies installed on his computer by configuring the browser options, if he does not allow the installation of cookies in his browser, he may not be able to access any of the sections of our website.

4.- Cookies used.

"GALICANAR, S.L.U." uses on this website the following cookies that are detailed below:

Analytical Cookies

- utma: It is used to count how many times a user visits the site. Expires after 2 years.
- utmz: It is used to know how a user has reached the web. Expires after 6 months
- utmb: It is used to calculate the time the user has been on the web for statistical purposes. Expires 30 minutes from the last pageview record.
- utmc: It is used to calculate the time the user has been on the web for statistical purposes. It expires at the end of the session.
- infCookie: Informs if the information message about the use of cookies on the web has been displayed. Expires after 5 years.
- has_js: Informs if javascript has been enabled in the browser configuration. Expires when the browser is closed
- SESS*: It is used to store the id of the PHP session, being * a long alphanumeric value. Expires when the browser is closed.

- The session identifier cookie in case of using the mail form, to be able to use the anti-spam verification code of the form, with name PHPSESSID and variable content depending on the browser session identifier.
- The domain Cookie <https://www.lanissuites.com/> through which the web will be redirected to its final accommodation, which does not load any other cookie
- And the cookies loaded by both Google and Facebook and other networks when using their plugins.
